Parents Code of Ethics

1. It is understood that playing time and positional decisions will be determined by the DirtDogs Vazquez coaching staff.

1(a) There is to be **NO COACHING FROM THE SIDELINE OR BLEACHERS DURING A GAME**. This is distracting to the player, other players and coaching staff and will not be tolerated. First offense is warning. Second offense will result in removal of player from game. Subsequent offenses will result in removal of tournament and/or release from DirtDogs Vazquez.

2. Support the DirtDogs Vazquez program at the ballpark and at your home. Your daughter's attitude many times will be an exact reflection of your own.

3. Parents play a large role in the success of their daughters and are therefore encouraged to travel with the team. When this is not possible, it is the responsibility of the parent to arrange their daughters travel with another family.

4. Parents are important part of the game and should at **ALL TIMES**: conform to accept standards of good sportsmanship and behavior. NO negative remarks towards other parents, players or coaches.

5. Parents should, at all times, respect officials, coaches, ASA officials and opponent's crowd and extend courtesies to them. Enthusiastic and wholesome cheering is encouraged. Booing and disrespecting remarks should be avoided at all times. Parents should be positive with their daughters and teammates.

There is ZERO tolerance for disrespectful behavior toward players, coaches, parents or family members.

6. As parents' behavior effect player behavior, parents should encourage all people to observe the Player Code of Ethics as well as the goals and objectives of the program as a whole.

7. No alcohol will be present with the DirtDogs Vazquez at the ballpark, parking lot or athletic facility of any kind. Please use appropriate courtesy when it comes to alcohol and smoking after the day's competition. There is an absolute zero tolerance for any type of illicit drug use, possession or influence.

8. Any concerns regarding the team shall be directed to the head coach. The head coach will not discuss team issues at inappropriate times such as pregame, game time or immediately following a game. If you have any concerns a parent must set up a meeting 24 hours after a game has ended to discuss issues with the head coach. NO QUESTIONING OF ANOTHER PLAYERS PLAYING TIME.

9. No parents allowed in the dugouts or near the dugouts unless specifically asked to by the head coach. Players are required to be responsible young athletes. They must come prepared with all practice/game equipment. Contact with players should be minimal and out of necessity. Refer back to 1(a).

10. All payments must be paid on time. A players' practice/game time will be affected if the parents fail to make payments. Also, aside from monthly dues, payment for players athletic training with Oak

Strength Academy are due on the first practice each month. If you have concerns regarding the payment schedule, talk with your head coach to resolve any issues.

11. In case of any injuries, granted their mobility, players are expected to attend all practices.

12. Players who participate in after school activities are encouraged to attend practice immediately after the event is completed.

13. It is understood that Dirdogs Vazquez is committed to providing the team with multiple opportunities to play as many games as possible. Therefore, at any time we may schedule a friendly or practice on a day other than our scheduled practice time, and all players are expected to attend. Missing a practice, friendly or game for a lesson will not be tolerated.

14. PLAYING TIME IS NOT GUARANTEED.

15. All team zooms are mandatory. If players are not able to attend they must communicate ahead of time to their coach why. If they fail to communicate they have agreed to sit out one game in the upcoming tournament/friendlies.
